

Missouri Highway 58 Utilities Relocation Project Belton, Missouri

City of Belton, Missouri

This project involved the relocation and replacement of sanitary sewers and water main lines along Hwy 58 between Holmes Road and North Scott in Belton, Missouri. MoDOT designed the widening of the two lane road requiring relocation of all utilities along the route. The City contracted with **DRG** to design the utility relocations for 5,500 lineal feet of sanitary sewers and 12,000 lineal feet of water mains. The City directed **DRG** to install a 16-inch diameter main line along Highway 58 to accommodate future growth west of town. **DRG** provided design of the pipelines, isolation valves and relief valves, and connections to current main lines. ***Design of the work was completed within budget and in accordance with the tight timeframe that was allocated for this work due to the construction schedule established by MoDOT.***

A water impact fee structure and ordinance was produced for the City which allowed the City to collect revenue to address growth related improvements in the system.
